PLACE: The Judsons host the weekend at their [Quarter-Circle Circle Guest Ranch](#). The Ranch is located 48 miles southeast of Gunnison and 45 miles west of Saguache. **SEE MAP ON BACK.**

WORKOUTS WILL BE: August 7th — 10:00 am & 2:00 pm — We will be doing this outdoors and footwear is recommended.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE: You are welcome to arrive Friday the 6th in the afternoon or Saturday morning in time for the morning workout. We hope you will stay thru the **BBQ supper and campfire Saturday evening** and then depart sometime Sunday.

COST if PAID IN ADVANCE: Persons working out, \$25. Those not working out, \$15. Children under 10 not working out are free.

COST if PAID upon arrival AUGUST 6th or 7th: Persons working out \$35. Those not working out, \$20.

CAMPING & CAMPER PARKING: Circle the motor homes, campers and tents — AND ENJOY. NO hookups available. NO additional charge.

BATHING & SANITATION: There is a privacy fenced outdoor shower with hot & cold running water. Weather permitting, it is great fun. Drinking and wash water must be drawn from our spring using a bucket. Campers need to bring buckets. There are clean, two seater outhouses for your use.

MEALS: **BBQ supper Saturday night will be provided, no extra charge.** You are responsible for all other meals. It is 45 miles to the nearest grocery store or restaurant, so do come prepared. Cabins are set up for light housekeeping with everything you should need to prepare & eat your meals. Campers will need camp stoves & coolers or be prepared to fix their meals on our charcoal grill or campfire. Charcoal is provided. Bring coolers and ice to preserve food and cool drinks. The ranch does not have a store.

WHAT TO BRING: Dress as you would on a camping trip. August is a warm month, but at over 9000 feet in elevation, nights are cool. Bring some warm clothes and jackets. Rain is possible and rain gear is recommended. It could even frost at night.

PETS: It is preferred that you don't bring them. If you do, they **MUST BE MAINTAINED ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES.** \$6.00 per night per pet will be charged and you are responsible for any damage they do. This applies to all pets.

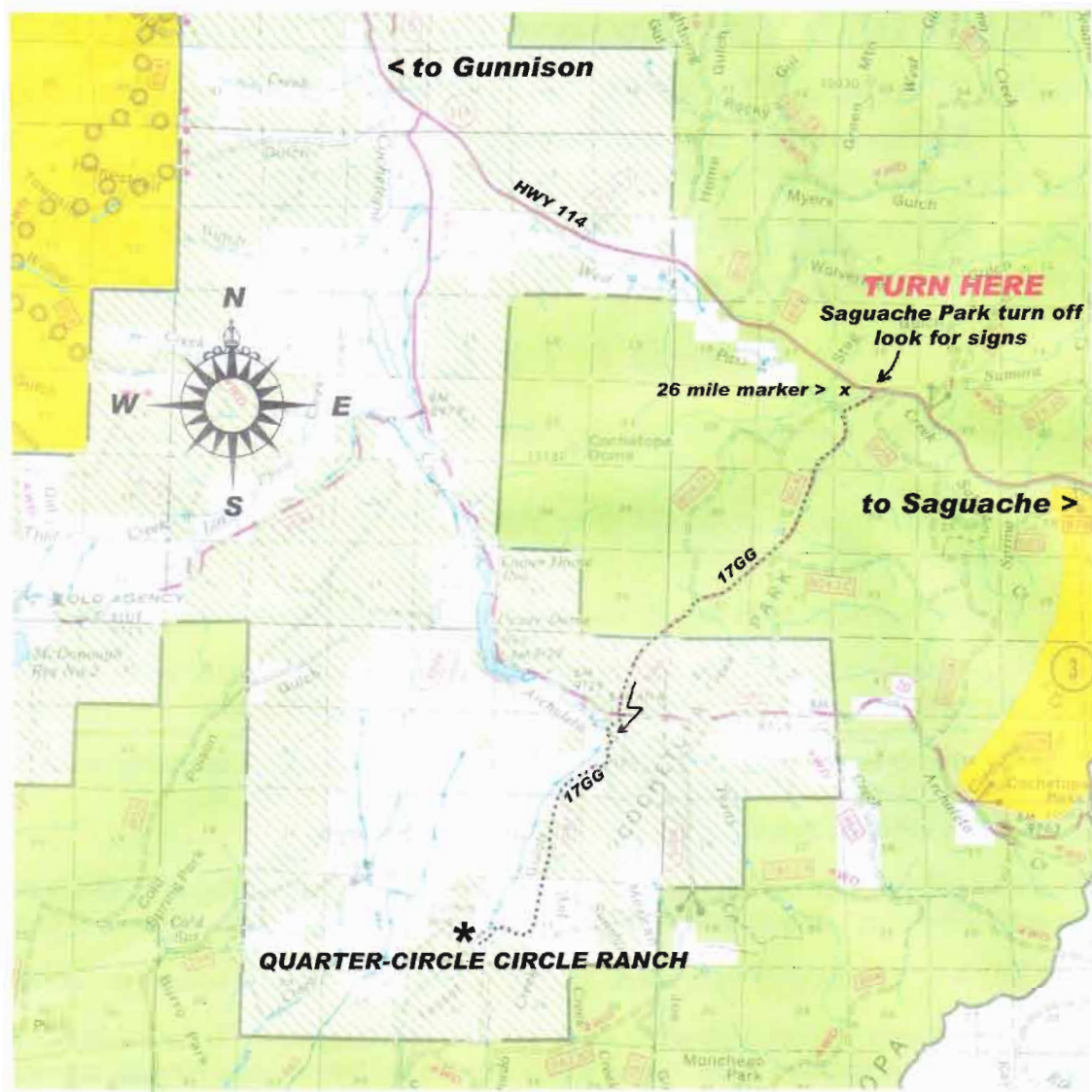
ACTIVITIES AVAILABLE AT and AROUND THE RANCH: *Fishing:* There are 3 ponds with Brook Trout in them for your enjoyment. This area has over 100 miles of public stream fishing available nearby. The Judsons can direct you to the best spots. *Horseback Rides:* The Judsons can take up to 6 guests at a time for rides on and around, the ranch and on the nearby National Forest and BLM lands. \$20.00 for a one hour ride. *Volleyball & Horseshoes:* For your enjoyment along with a swing set for the little kids. *Hiking, Mountain Biking and 4WD Adventure:* The ranch is surrounded by BLM, and the Gunnison National Forest and is close to the Rio Grande National Forests. Many opportunities to enjoy your public lands exist. The Judsons can direct you to it.

RANCH LOCATION: Take Hwy 114 either 8 miles east of Gunnison, or in Saguache. The 26-mile marker is on the west slope side of the Continental Divide. Just east of the 26-mile marker is the Saguache Park / Archuleta Creek turn off. This only goes south. When you turn here you will see our Quarter-Circle Circle Ranch sign. It is 10 miles to the ranch from here. There are Ranch signs from Hwy 114 to the ranch. We will also have TKD signs up from the highway to the ranch to help you in. The signs and map above will get you here.

TO GIVING US A CALL: The Ranch is located well beyond the phone lines and does not have cellular service. We do have 2-way radio attached to the phone system. Phone conversations with us will be a little different than you are used to. You cannot hear and talk at the same time and there is a slight pause between your stopping talking and hearing us. Please bear with us on this. If you don't get an answer when you call, please try back later. There is always someone here, but we are often away from the phone with our guests, or working with the horses, cattle, chickens, goats or whatever, feeding, milking, fixing etc.
